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This STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT for the breeding season of 2009, is made and entered into on _____ day of _____, 2009 and is by and between Classical Baroque LLC hereafter designated as Breeder and _____ hereafter designated as Mare Owner. Mare Owner grants permission to breed below described mare, to the stallion known as "Mattias" or FHANA registered name "Sietse fan Bonnie View", purebred Friesian stallion for the breeding fee of \$ _____. This breeding shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Fees.** The \$ _____ breeding fee includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$250, due upon execution of this contract. The balance of \$ _____ is due before first delivery of shipped semen, unless other arrangements were made in advance. Shipping charges are due before semen is shipped. No breeder's certificate will be furnished until all balances are paid in full.
- 2. Payment of fees.** The \$250 non-refundable booking fee is payable upon receipt of this contract. The remaining balance of the stud fee is due before semen is shipped to Mare Owner. All fees may be paid via major credit card through paypal. Instructions will be sent to those who prefer this option, plus the fee for it. Mare owner's who prefer to send a check may do so by making it payable to "Classical Baroque LLC" and forwarding it to the address above. There will be a \$25 charge for all returned checks.
- 3. Collection and shipping.** The fee for 1st semen collection is included in booking fee. Additional collections will result in a \$250 fee if required. Breeder must received reasonable notice of desired collection and shipment dates. Mare owner is to advise breeder upon start of the mare's cycle and contact breeder again the day prior to desired collection and shipment. Breeder cannot guarantee shipment on the desired date without this information. Semen is first come, first served, so please call at start of mare's cycle to make sure you are placed on priority list.

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4. **Collection schedule.** Request for shipping of semen MUST BE received at least 24 hours in advance. There is a limit of two shipments per mare cycle. Each shipment will contain two doses (enough for two inseminations in same mare). These doses are for one mare stated on this contract only. **These doses should be done twice, not all at the same time, for maximum conception results.**
5. **Extra Charges.** The Breeder will not charge a courier charge for transporting the semen either thru Federal Express or UPS. But please note there may be an extra shipping charge for Saturday delivery. Stallion owner will notify you if there is an extra charge.
6. **Live Foal guarantee.** A live foal is defined as a new born foal that stands and nurses without assistance. If the Mare Owner does not receive a live foal (as the result of the death or absence of the foal), Mare Owner will receive a return breeding privilege for the next year breeding season, but only if Breeder is notified within 30 days of loss and receives a licensed veterinarian's statement confirming death. Mare bred should be checked for pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian at approximately 18 and again at 45 days after the last date of insemination. Failure to accurately report status of mare in question in a prompt manner could render the live foal guarantee null and void. If after pronounced safe in foal, the mare should miscarry, abort or prove barren, Mare Owner has the privilege to request additional semen shipments during the current breeding season, Feb 1st through Sept 31st, 2009 or the following breeding season.
7. **Mare Condition.** A veterinarian breeding soundness exam is highly recommended and a uterine culture is required prior to shipping semen. If the mare fails to settle in foal after two cycles, breeder may require the Mare Owner to obtain a current reproductive exam/uterine culture prior to any further shipments, plus an additional booking fee. Having an advance culture /breeding soundness exam helps all parties involved settle your mare in a timely and cost effective manner.
8. **Stallion health.** It is further agreed that should the stallion die or be declared infertile by a veterinarian before the mare settles (with maximum time limit of September 31, 2009) any fees paid, less expenses, will be refunded to Mare Owner, thereby canceling the breeding contract.
9. **Booking fees.** All booking fees are non-refundable. If a mare fails to settle in three cycles, an additional \$250 booking fee will be required. Should the mare die or prove infertile, Breeder will accept another mare according to the terms and conditions of this contract. However, more than one transfer of the mare booked may require an additional booking fee.

This contract is non-transferable without prior written approval from Breeder.
Breeding season commences from Feb 30th to September 1st.

This contract is entered into the State of Illinois, County of DuPage, and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of this state. If any clause in the contract is against state law, then that clause shall be null and void. All other terms and conditions will remain in effect.
